






Poultry Production in Brazil - History


Role of the government to stimulate Brazilian poultry production changed in time

- Development of required structure (ports, roads,...)







- Brazilian company or agricultural research

Brazilian Poultry - Association - Government and Industry

- Sanitary regionalization:
 - Define sanitary status by regions
 - Optimize zoo sanitary control
 - Guarantee maintenance of external commercialization from areas not affected by disease

• Depends on:

- Geolocation of all production sites
- Regional transport routes and barriers in case of outbreak
- Acceptance with WOAH (World Organization for Animal Health) standards
- Acceptance from other veterinary bodies from external countries

Carrefour CEO announces boycott of Mercosur meat in France



The CEO of Carrefour, Alexandre Bompard, published a statement on his social networks in which he committed to the French supermarket chain not selling any meat from Mercosur in its units in France.

The restriction on Brazil, Argentina, Paraguay and Uruguay comes amid a wave of protests by French farmers against the proposed free trade agreement between the European Union and the South American bloc.

"risk of meat production that does not meet its requirements and standards spreading across the French market" ... "at Carrefour, we are ready, whatever the price and quantity of meat that Mercosur will offer us".



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
